RESOLUTION ON ENHANCING THE INTENSIFICATION OF REGIONAL COOPERATION AND CONCERTED EFFORT BASED UPON THE PRINCIPLE OF SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

The 34th AIPA General Assembly,

- 1. **Recalling** Resolution 33GA/2012/Soc/03 adopted in the 33rd AIPA General Assembly during the 9th AIPA Fact-Finding Committee to Combat the Drug Menace in Yogyakarta, Indonesia;
- 2. **Reaffirming** that the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs 1961 as amended by the 1972 Protocol, the Convention on Psychotropic Substances of 1971 and the United Nations Convention against Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances of 1988 constitute the framework and instrument for the international community to fight against the world drug problem;
- 3. **Recalling** the ASEAN Leaders' Statement during the 22nd ASEAN Summit held on 24th April 2013 in Brunei Darussalam that emphasizes on the importance of the Declaration on Drug-Free ASEAN 2015;
- 4. Reiterating the commitments of ASEAN Member States contained in the ASEAN Leaders' Declaration on Drug-Free ASEAN 2015 adopted at the 20th ASEAN Summit in Cambodia, 2012 and the Chairman's Statement of the 1st Special ASEAN Ministerial Meeting on Drug Matters in Thailand, 2012;
- Recognizing the extensive work of the ASEAN Senior Officials Meeting on Drug Matters (ASOD), particularly in their efforts to implement the ASEAN Work Plan on Combatting Illicit Drug Production, Trafficking and
