The 38th General Assembly of the APPU,

Noting that whales have become very important to the economic development of the South Pacific Small Island Nations and,

<u>Recognizing</u> the depletion of the whale population during the last century and the lack of a reliable source of information with regard to the different whale populations in the South Pacific and,

Aware that most South Pacific Island Nations have started to offer whale watching as a means of increasing income from tourism for small island states and,

<u>Noting</u> the need for solidarity among member nations of APPU to enhance the economic growth of member nations of the APPU,

NOW THEREFORE;

Calling on all members of APPU to support and endorse this proposal for a South Pacific Whale Sanctuary and,

Urging members of APPU who are members of International Organizations like the International Whaling Commission to support the South Pacific Whale Sanctuary as a means of enhancing economic development of island nations of APPU.

Hereby resolves that a South Pacific Whale Sanctuary be adopted.
